Daisy takes advantage of the OpenType technology, a cross-platform font format developed by Adobe and Microsoft. It enables fonts to contain a large number of characters, provides advanced typographic features and can be used on both Macintosh and Windows computers. The typographic layout features can be accessed via the OpenType palette (Illustrator) or the Character palette (Indesign and Quarkxpress). All possible glyphs of the font can be seen in the Glyph palette.

Standard Ligatures (liga)

This activates standard ligatures which are designed to avoid collisions between letters and create a more elegant text.

fi fl → fi fl

Contextual Alternates (calt)

Daisy uses the calt feature (on by default in Adobe Indesign and QuarkXpress) to avoid collisions between letters.

fè fã fō → fè fã fō et cetera

Contextual Ligatures (clig)

More ligatures, which are not covered by the liga feature.

fü fö fä fe fi → fü fö fä fe fi

Stylistic Sets (ss01/ss02) / Stylistic Alternates (salt)

Alternate characters are available via Stylistic Sets (Indesign) or Stylistic Alternates (QuarkXpress, Illustrator, Photoshop).
